For going out in the evening there is something for every taste. There are a lot of bars and clubs in the city centre as well as the university area. During the summer, students relax in Braunschweig's many parks or in the beach clubs and cafés along the Oker River. In winter, there is the Christmas market which takes place in the historic setting of the Old Town and is rated among the most beautiful in the country.

Those who love nature find little paradises like the nature reserve in Riddagshausen you just 15 minutes from the city centre by bike. There you will find the historic fishing lakes of the former monastery, rare trees and tracks for jogging, skating, or cycling. Climbers, hikers, mountain bikers and winter sport enthusiasts will love the Harz mountain range which is only 40 minutes away by car. And if, for a change, you want to spend the weekend in a large metropolis, just hop on board a train or a coach and you will reach Hamburg in two hours or Berlin in just 90 minutes.
