Located in the heart of Germany, Ilmenau is a mid-sized town in an eco-friendly environment. Surrounded by vast green hilly landscapes, the Thuringian Forest and just 40 km south of the Thuringian state's capital Erfurt, Ilmenau is a bustling student town. TU Ilmenau is a modern campus university, offering lecture halls, dormitories, student canteens, a supermarket and student clubs - all in one place and within a short walking distance. High-speed trains connect our students to the large international German hubs like Frankfurt, Berlin and Munich. Among our 4.500 students, 44 % are international, representing over 100 countries.

3.1 What kind of services do you offer to international students and especially for KOSPIE students?

KOSPIE students, are free to choose from our university's entire <u>course catalogue</u>, with offers in German and English, regardless of their study program and degree (Bachelor/Master).

During the orientation week, KOSPIE students are welcomed by our staff and senior students to the campus and introduced to the university, the city and their peers.





KOSPIE students are also accompanied by a student assistant who provides support during the study stay in Ilmenau (welcome service, support with formalities and everyday life questions).

Our "Fit for Study" workshop prepares students for successful study experiences in Germany. To help students find the right internship, Career Counseling supports the preparation of a personalised application and provides presentation training. The career fair <u>inovailmenau</u> takes place on campus too.

Our international student service "we4you" enriches students' social and intercultural experiences. On offer are weekly events and excursions, e.g. city trips to Erfurt and Weimar, hiking tours, game nights, bowling and a lot more.


3.2 What are the most special attractions for international students in the region? *(up to 250 words)*

Our campus offers a variety of options for getting involved, meeting new people and fostering your skills. Choose from a variety of student associations like Young Engineers, Team Starcraft, Engineers Without Borders, and the FEM- Research Association for Electronic Media. Dive into activities at our student-run radio station or cinema. Four student-run clubs and a café on campus offer fun and relaxing spots for socialising. You can either participate in the events or become an active member. The university sports centre features a modern sports hall, a gym, a climbing wall and outdoor fields, with about 90 different sport offers to choose from, including team sports, martial arts, dancing and swimming.



Ilmenau itself features a public indoor and outdoor swimming pool, ice-skating rink, cinema, downhill track and numerous scenic hiking trails in the surrounding forests. The city has a long winter sports tradition, mainly in bobsledding. You might even spot Olympic champions around town. Try sledding for yourself on the town's summer toboggan run or learn to ski in the winter.

Comment: TU Ilmenau does not charge tuition fees. However, all students, including KOSPIE students, must pay a semester contribution fee, which is standard at all German universities. This fee is a mandatory social contribution to the student body. It includes a contribution to the "Studierendenwerk Thüringen", which provides student rates for housing and meals at the canteen. It also includes a nationwide ticket for regional trains.

The housing situation in Ilmenau is highly favourable, with plenty of affordable options for students. By arrangement with the <u>Studierendenwerk</u> (responsible for residential homes for students), we can guarantee a room to all exchange students, including KOSPIE students, who apply for student housing by 31 July each year. As you will receive your letter of invitation in the spring, you will have ample time to apply for a room. The Studierendenwerk offers single rooms in shared apartments as well as a small number of single apartments. Shared apartments are especially recommended for exchange students, as they facilitate quicker social connections and networking.
