The University is named after Otto von Guericke (1602-1686), the renowned son of Magdeburg, who became a world figure for his pioneering research on the vacuum. Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) was founded in 1993, and is thus one of the youngest universities in Germany. It has evolved from the former Otto von Guericke University of Technology, the Teachers Training College and the Medical Academy. With nine faculties and almost 12,500 students - among them around 4000 international students from 102 countries- the university is gaining in importance as a centre of teaching and research right in the middle of the city.

With 90 courses of study, OVGU offers optional education in different subjects and fields of specialisation. Correspondingly, there is a great variety of possible combinations among the





faculties' range of offerings. The favourable study facilities include modern laboratories and clinics with high-end computer technology.
