Offenburg University has campuses in Offenburg and the nearby town of Gengenbach in southwestern Germany. The calm and peaceful Ortenau region is considered a «gateway to the Black Forest», yet is only short distances away from larger cities such as Karlsruhe, Freiburg, Strasbourg (France), and Basel (Switzerland), all within an hour from Offenburg by train.

Both Offenburg and Gengenbach offer safe and high-quality living and a comfortable climate, with pleasant summers and winter temperatures rarely dropping below zero degrees.

- We have an experienced member of staff that supports students with finding suitable accommodation, before arriving to Hochschule Offenburg.
- We support incoming exchange students through our buddy programme, where experienced students support new incoming exchange students upon their arrival in Germany. Typical support includes picking up arrivals at the train station, helping with finding your way around in Offenburg, support with formalities.
- Additional support is of course provided by the International Center of Offenburg University. All our staff are fluent in English and we have a number of staff that are fluent in Spanish as well. In addition, each of the four departments has designated professors as contacts for international students.
- We provide a range of social activities to get to know other students as well as the area, such as excursions and fun events for all international students at Hochschule Offenburg.

# 3.2 What are the most special attractions for international students in the region? (up to 250 words)

- Black Forest and mountain range: The beautiful scenery right next to Offenburg is a very popular travel destination for hiking, mountain biking and other outdoor activities.
- Europa Park Rust: This popular theme park attracts visitors from all over the world with roller coaster rides, a water park and many exciting activities and events.
- City of Strasbourg: A mere 20 minute train ride away from Offenburg, Strasbourg provides all the shopping amenities, cultural facilities and entertainments of a major city. Looking for a break from Offenburg? Need a specific exotic ingredient for that special dish? Fancy an authentic French coffee or dinner? With Strasbourg being so close, this is always an option. The cathedral is also world famous and a popular tourist destination.
- Historic city centre of Gengenbach: Gengenbach is the location of our second campus, located in a beautiful former monastery with a chapel. Gengenbach is also visited by over one million of people a year and boasts a beautiful historic city center and many bijou cafés and shops.
- Visits to Heidelberg: Do you wish to travel the paths of Immanuel Kant or Max Weber? Visit one of the most famous and recognisable castle ruins in Europe? Enjoy the student night life of a city that is famous for its large student population? Heidelberg is always well worth a visit and easily reachable by train from Offenburg.
