Reutlingen is located in the federal state of Baden-Württemberg, which generates a large part of Germany's powerful economy. Third-largest of the German Länder in terms of population and area, Baden-Württemberg is a leader in Germany's exports, research, and development. Reutlingen, a city with about 115,000 inhabitants, is a modern industrial center with a strong service sector. Whilst Baden-Württemberg is home to several large international firms like Daimler, Porsche and Bosch, most of the state's firms are small-to medium-size businesses (Mittelstand) producing highly innovative, world-leading niche products. Baden-Württemberg is the birthplace of the car and, as a manufacturing location, has an excellent reputation in the global automotive industry.

3.1 What kind of services do you offer to international students and especially for KOSPIE students? (up to 150 words)

For many years, Reutlingen University has been a leader in international student exchanges. We welcome a large number of international students coming from more than 180 partner universities and offer the following welcome services:

- Intensive course "German Language and Culture" (three weeks of intensive presemester language training if required by DAAD including accompanying programme consisting of welcome service and tours of the towns of Reutlingen and Tübingen, excursions to Lake Constance, Black Forest and Heidelberg, intercultural training, application training, workshops and individual counselling and assistance with registration formalities and further leisure activities (barbecue, evening sessions with films, games or sports).
- Tutoring programme "Students4Students": Reutlingen students help new exchange students to settle in to life on campus.
- Job fairs with numerous partners from industry are hosted every semester on campus. These are excellent opportunities for students to speak directly to recruiters about internship placements.





• Orientation event in each faculty/study program: assistance with enrolment formalities, course counselling and various other aspects of a successful study abroad stay.

 - •Extracurricular activities for international and German students such as hiking tours, barbecues or iceskating are organized by the Reutlingen International Office, the Local Erasmus+ Initiative and the Protestant-Catholic University Community (EKHG).
 - •Each year in October we visit the Cannstatter Volksfest in Stuttgart, which is the second largest public festival in Germany.
 - •Each fall semester, Reutlingen University organizes company visits for international students to automobile manufacturers such asMercedes-Benz, Porsche or Audi. Guided tours of the plants provide participants with exclusive insights into various steps of the highly complex car manufacturing process.
 - •Attractive location: The cities of Stuttgart, Tübingen and the hills of the Swabian Alb areall within easy reach from Reutlingen. France, Switzerland and Austria are bordering the stateof Baden-Württemberg which makes it easy to travel there during the weekend.
